Many pupils have additional complex needs including autistic spectrum disorders, epilepsy, physical and sensory impairments; many need regular medical intervention.

We want to recruit an enthusiastic and energetic full time Nursery Nurse to join the Woodfield team, working with all age groups throughout the school. Applicants must be a qualified NNEB or equivalent eg. CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Child Care and Education or BTEC National Diploma in Children's Care, Learning and Development or NVQ Level 3 in Children's Care, Learning and Development.

There is also a requirement to attend weekly staff meetings, termly parents' evenings and regular INSET training. The post will involve being part of a supportive 'Teaching and Learning' team within a class setting. You will have opportunities to develop your own skills through on-going training. Your contribution to the development of the school will be encouraged, valued and supported. A good sense of humour, enthusiasm, flexibility and commitment are essential. The ability to work within a team is vital.

Experience of working with pupils who have learning difficulties and/or complex needs would be an advantage but not essential as induction will be provided.
