Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium 2018-2019

Background

The Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium is provided to all state-funded schools with a Year 7 cohort, including special schools. It provides schools with an additional £500 for each Year 7 pupil who did not achieve at Least National Level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

Purpose

The additional funding is to provide Year 7 pupils with extra support in literacy and/or mathematics in Year 7 in order to reach their full potential.

How is the Premium used?

Each Year 7 pupil is assessed to inform the best way to use the additional funding which may include:

- Additional staffing to support differentiated learning experiences.
- Intensive small group tuition
- The purchasing of external services and materials to add to those provided by the school, such as music therapy.
