

Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, thank you all for your continued support and understanding through these unprecedented challenging times as we deal with the impact of the coronavirus.

The Senior Leadership Team are meeting regularly throughout each day to review the ever changing situation that we are all in. We appreciate that anxiety levels of all of us are high at the moment as we all deal with the unknown.

Following various updates today, I would like to clarify a couple of points:

1. At this current moment, school will be open tomorrow, Friday 20th March; and we plan to be open every school day for the next two weeks of the term, providing we are able to ensure a safe environment for all pupils and staff. This is being reviewed daily bearing in mind information from the Government, Local Authority and considering staff and pupil attendance. We will update you of any changes to these plans at the earliest possible opportunity.
2. I would like to confirm that we have made the decision today that we **WILL NOT** be opening during the Easter holidays. This decision has been discussed and agreed with by the Chair of Governors. Therefore I confirm that at the moment, school will remain open until Friday 3rd April. We will then plan to re-open for pupils on Tuesday 21st April.
