

Stay Home Stay Safe

If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be, it is the safest place for them.

In accordance with government recommendations we will offer childcare provision for a maximum of 10% of our pupil numbers in school on any one day. This is to protect both staff and pupils and reduce the spread of the virus.

We will set up a staff rota for after the Easter break, to provide childcare for the pupils of **critical workers** and pupils that the school has identified as vulnerable pupils (parents will be contacted by the school if this is the case). After risk assessing the situation the following steps have been taken/are in place to protect both staff and pupils as much as possible:

- Only one section of the school is open/in use (this means pupils are not in familiar classrooms/environments.)
- Staff Rota system (this mean pupils will be cared for by unfamiliar staff and different staff on different days)
- Staff will be exercising social distancing as much as practical (this means pupils will be encouraged to be 2m away from each other and staff at all times)

There is NO NURSE on site (She has been redeployed during the crisis)

Childcare Provision - qualifying children

If you are a **critical worker**, please complete the form below by Wednesday 1st April if you require essential childcare (because you cannot arrange your own) from after the Easter break, so that we can organise staffing.

Please note that this is a national emergency and we politely request that a request for provision is only made if parents/carers are critical workers.

Remember you do not have to send your child into school even if you qualify and Government advice is that all children should stay at home wherever possible as this is the safest option.
