Woodfield School is an outstanding (Ofsted November 2017) maintained Special School providing education for children and young people aged 3-19 with severe and profound learning needs. Many pupils have additional complex needs including autistic spectrum disorders, epilepsy, physical and sensory impairments; many need regular medical intervention.

Our PSA, Woodfield Association School Partners (WASP) committee consists of three elected members holding the positions of Chair, Andy Smith, Treasurer, Sheila Batchelor, and Secretary, Zoey Morris, along with others who are happy to give up their time to come along with ideas and enthusiasm to help us raise money for the school. No member of the WASP committee is paid. Everything they do is on a voluntary basis for the benefit of every pupil in the school.

We are very fortunate at our school to have a PSA that is, and has been, such an integral part of the school community for many years. Thousands of pounds have been raised and spent on improving equipment and resources to enhance our pupils' education and the facilities in school. WASP is about much more than just fundraising though. It helps support closer links between home and school, and it is an excellent way to bring staff, parents, families and friends together socially in support of the school, working towards a common goal. Over the last two years we have rebuilt our therapy pool complex with the invaluable financial support from parents, friends and organisations, and recently refurbished our school library as shown in the pictures below.

Our next project will be revamping our very tired looking sensory room at a cost of approximately £20,000, and this is very much in the planning phase.
